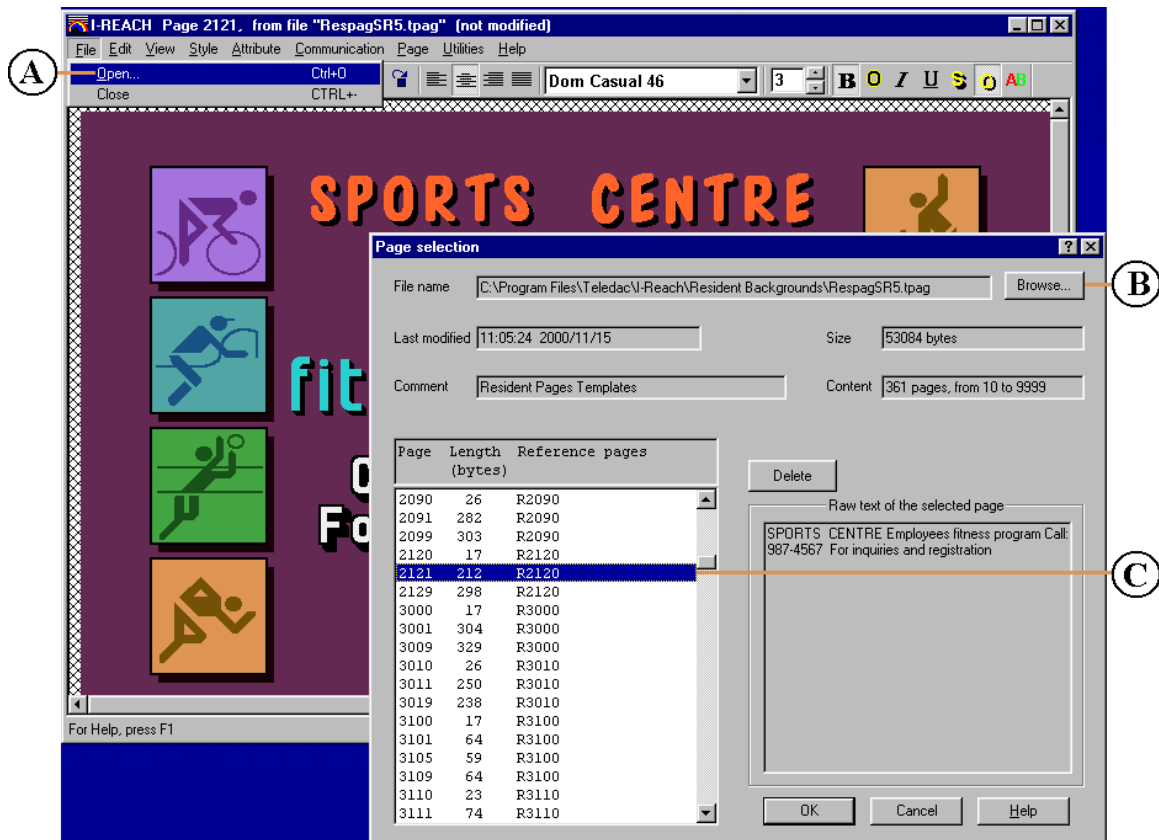


## Getting Started with I-Reach+ and Tellimage

### STEP 1: CREATE YOUR MESSAGE



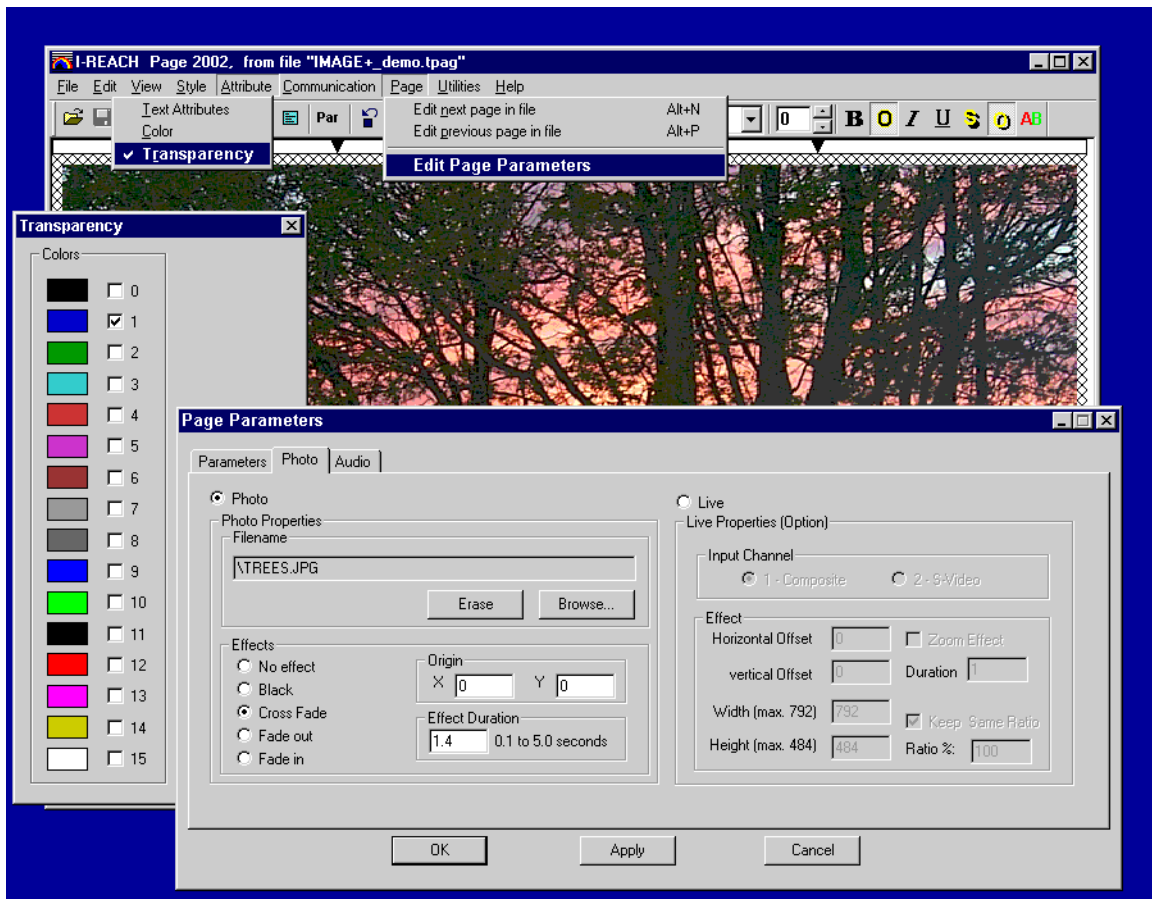
To create your personal pages, you can use the preprogrammed resident pages stored in the permanent memory of the Tellimage video billboard.

These templates can simply be modified by replacing the text example by your own message. Afterward, you can personalize it by modifying text attributes such as: text color, typeface style, formatting,...

To do it:

- Ⓐ -Select the **Open** option in the **File** menu.
- Ⓑ -Click the **Browse** button and select the resident pages file: **RespagSR5.tpag**
- Ⓒ -Then, click on the resident page you want to modify. (to avoid inadvertent overwriting the RespagSR5.tpag file, it is recommended to save immediately your new page in your own file as explained in step 4 G).

## STEP 2: ADDING AN IMAGE TO YOUR MESSAGE



Now, you can add an image in the background of your page

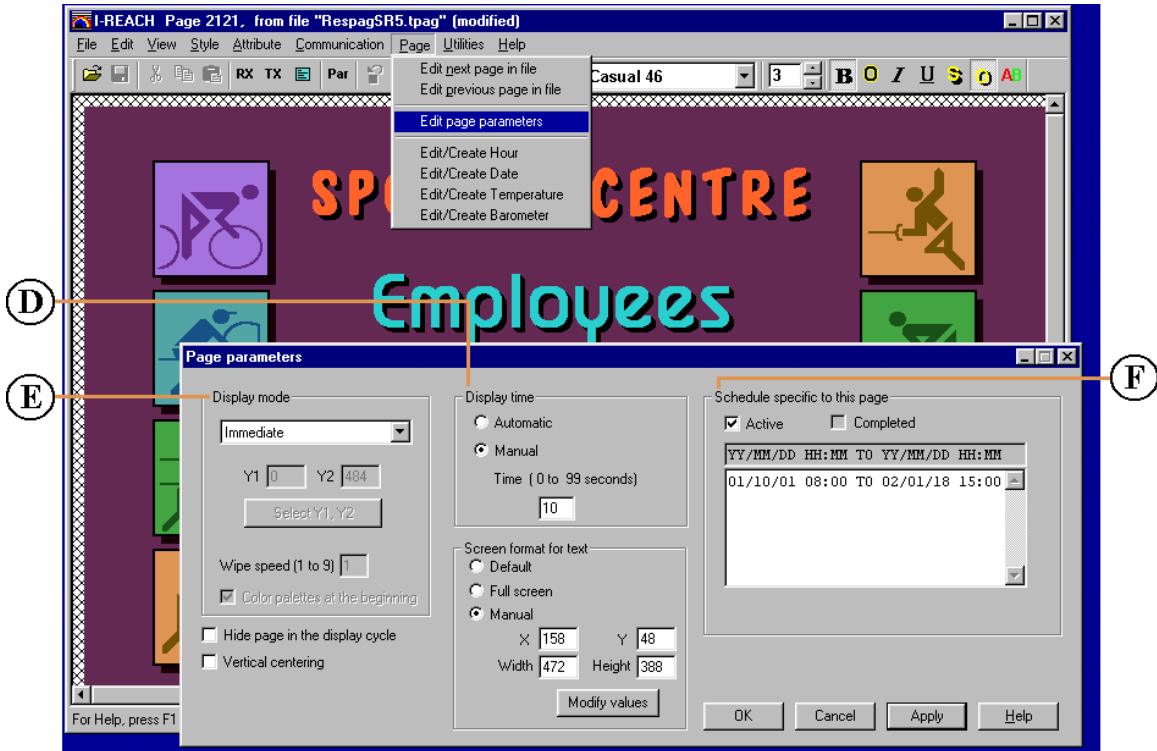
-Select the **Transparency** option in the **Attribute** menu, then select the background color that will become transparent (the background color selected will be replaced by a cross-hatch pattern, meaning this color number is now transparent ).

-Select the **Edit page parameters** option in the **Page** menu, then select an image stored in the folder **C:\IMG** of your Image+ unit (**All the image files must be stored under that root folder** so that the Tellimage system can find them & display them properly The root folder path can be set with "File menu – Select Image+ root folder").

**Note:** the image must be in "**windows bitmap**" or **.JPG** format and the maximum resolution(size) visible on screen is: **720 x 484 pixels**

In the example above, the **R10** resident page has been selected (a full screen blue background), then the **blue color number 1** used for the background was made **transparent** and the image file "**TREES.JPG**" has been selected for the background. This image file is stored in the **C:\IMG** of the Image+ unit and the file format is "window bitmap")

### STEP 3: MESSAGE TIMING & SCHEDULING



Once the page presentation is completed.

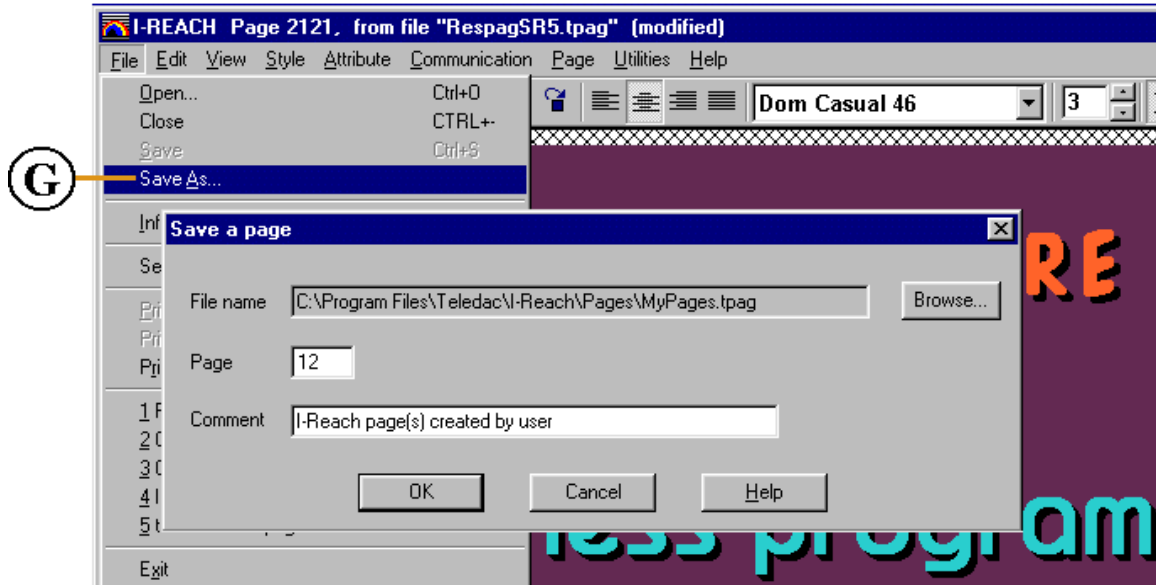
You must define the display parameters such as:

- Ⓓ -The page display time (how long this page will be displayed on screen)
- Ⓔ -The page display mode (how this page will appear on screen).
- Ⓕ -Optionally, you may define a schedule specific to this page

To do it:

- Select the **Edit page parameters** option in the **Page** menu, then enter your parameters.

## STEP 4: INSERT INTO DISPLAY SEQUENCE AND SAVE YOUR WORK



Now that all the parameters of the page are defined.

- ③ You can save and insert this page in your own master **Iristext** display file (filename: **MyPages.tpag**).

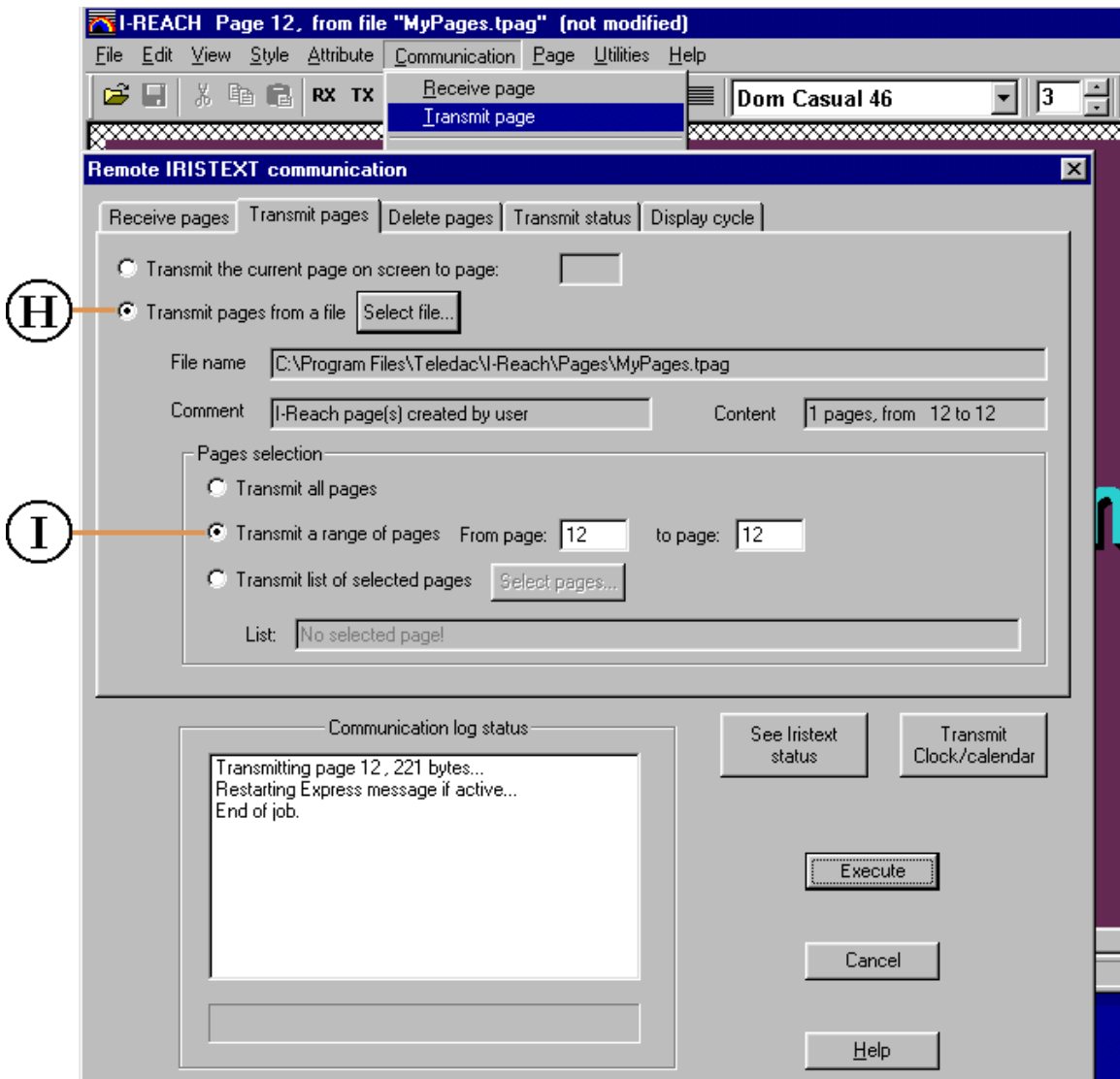
You must select a page number between 1 and 9999.

To do it:

- Select the **Save As** option in the **File** menu.  
(use Save for further updates in the currently open file)

To add other pages to your file repeat **step 1, 2, 3** and **4** and make sure to select a page number that does not overlap a page number previously saved in that file. Otherwise, the page will be replaced.

## STEP 5: TRANSMIT YOUR DISPLAY FILE TO IRISTEXT



Now, you are ready to transmit the content of your master **Iristext** display file to the Iristext Video Billboard unit.

- Ⓜ -You can choose to transmit only one or many pages.
- Ⓜ -Make sure that the group of pages transmitted is not overlapping another group of pages that was transmitted previously. Otherwise, the pages will be replaced.

To do it:

















































-Select the **Transmit Page** option in the **Communication** menu and do the appropriate selections.

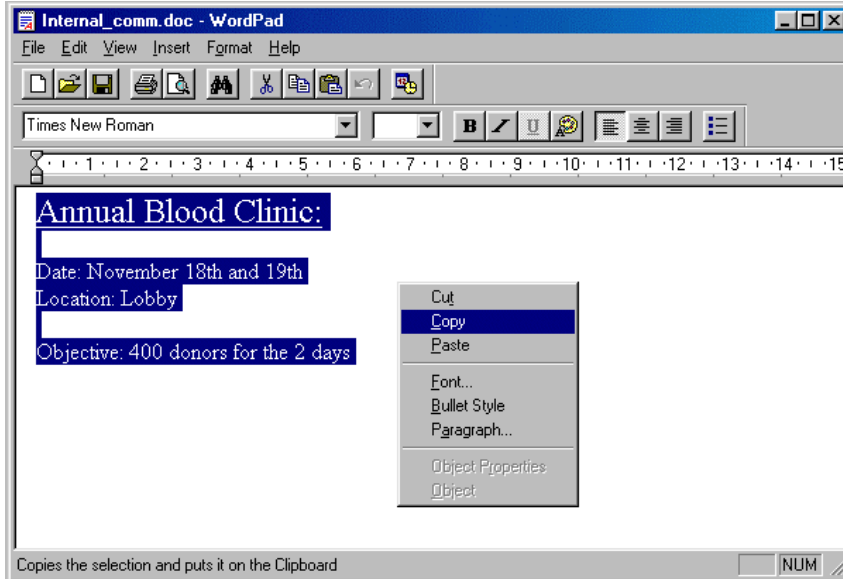

## Import Text with Copy-Paste function

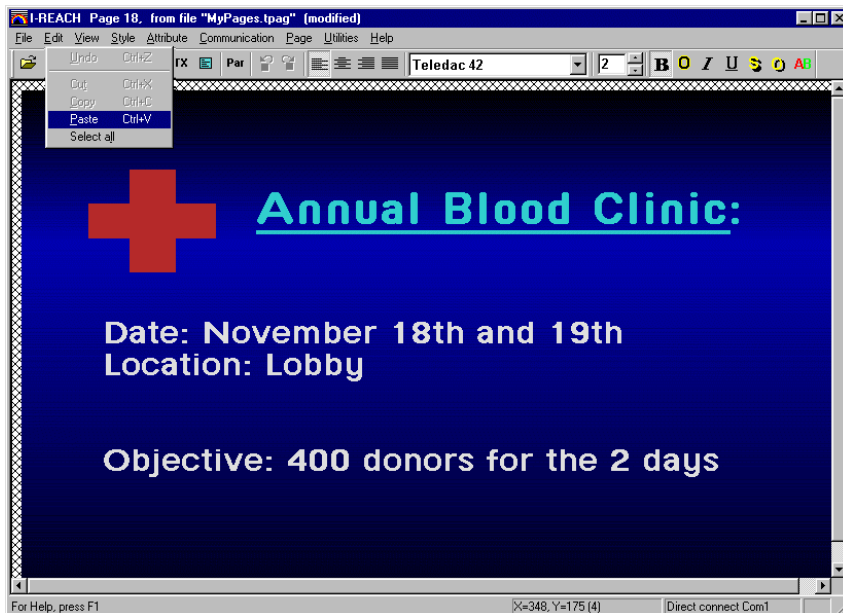
The example below shows how to import text from Windows applications to I-Reach+ software using the Copy and Paste function of Windows.

### STEP 2:











































Import the text in I-Reach by using the **Paste** option in the **Edit** menu





























